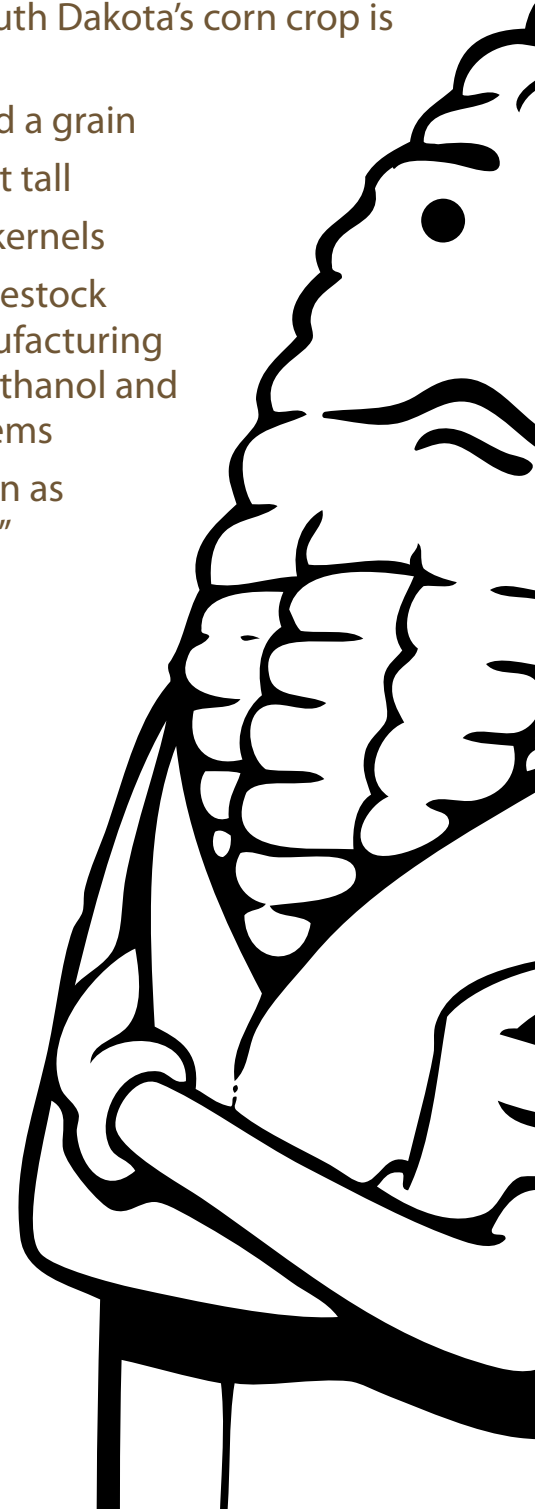

- 99% of South Dakota's corn crop is field corn
- Considered a grain
- 7 to 10 feet tall
- Hard, dry kernels
- Used as livestock feed, manufacturing material, ethanol and grocery items
- Also known as "dent corn"

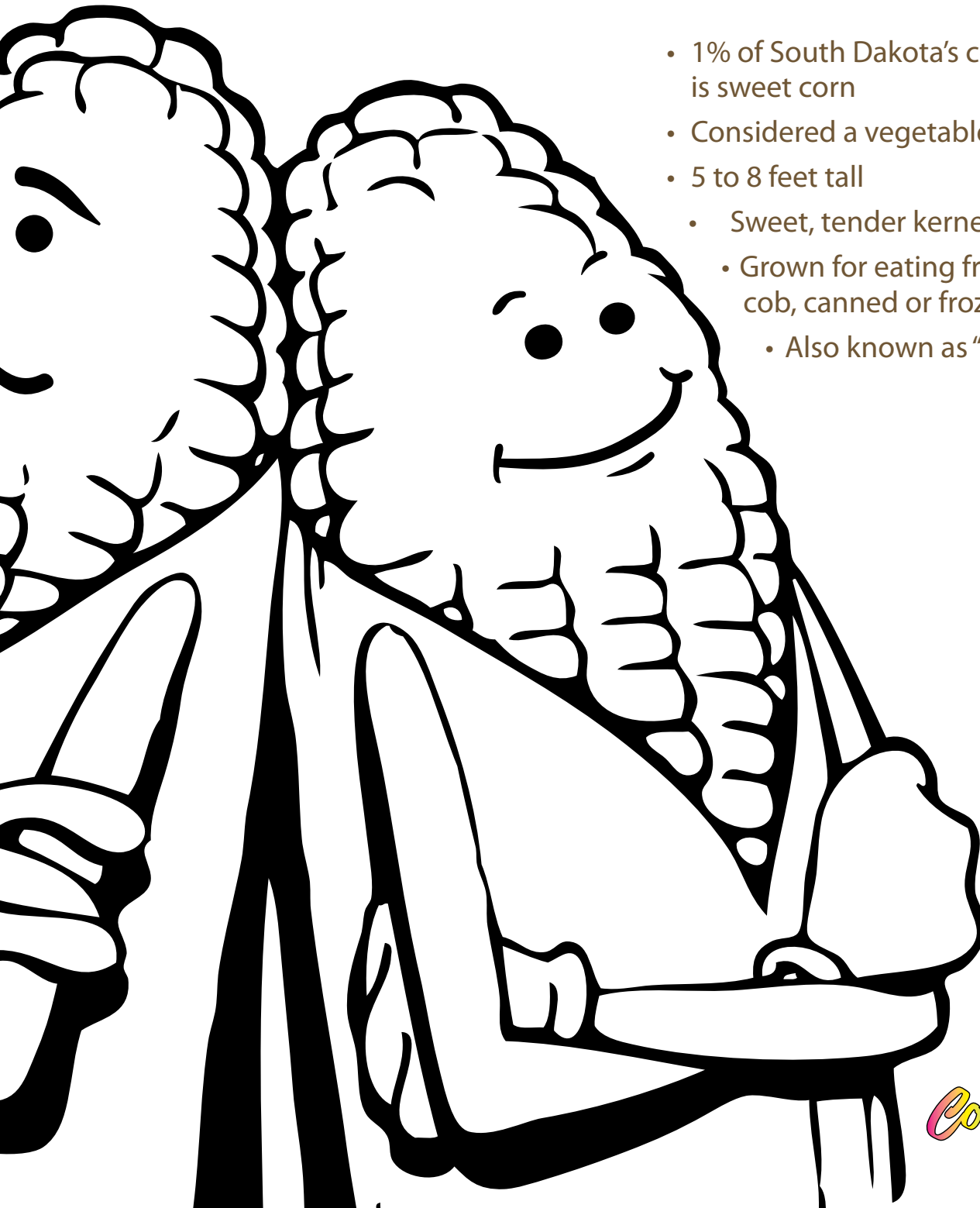


# THE TWO SIDES

## South Dakota Corn

### *Sweet* CORN

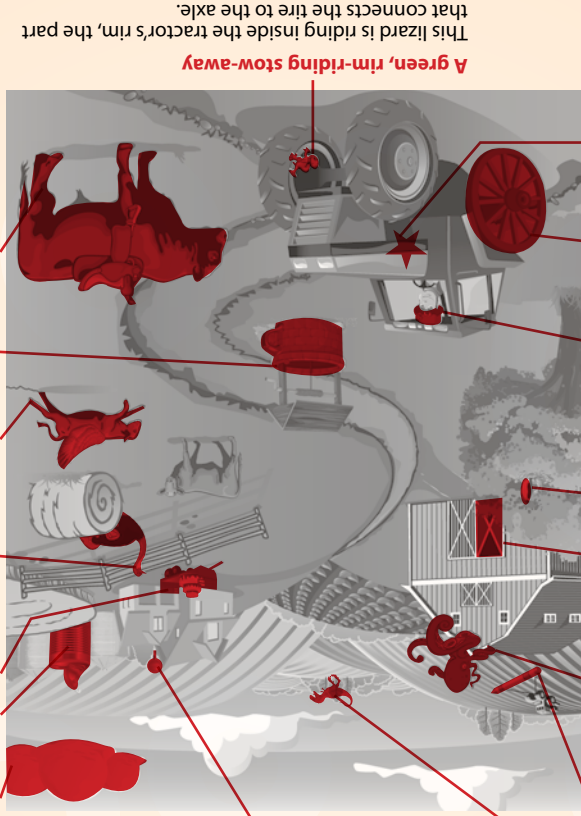
- 1% of South Dakota's corn crop is sweet corn
- Considered a vegetable
- 5 to 8 feet tall
  - Sweet, tender kernels
  - Grown for eating fresh off the cob, canned or frozen
    - Also known as "candy corn"

**A mixed-up, cold-loving, dressed-up bird** - Penguins are found in the Antarctic, not on a South Dakota farm! Their unique coloring makes them look like they are wearing a tuxedo!

**Inappropriate Irish head wear** - A leprechaun is a type of fairy in Irish folklore. It is not commonly worn by a farmer!

**A wagon's caster** - A caster is another name for a wheel. Wagons went out of use with the availability of tractors.

**Farmer's vehicle with an identity-crisis** - Some farmers prefer red tractors, some green. But they all agree that the two do not mix!

**A green, rim-riding stow-away** - This lizard is riding inside the tractor's rim, the part that connects the tire to the axle.

**Floating frozen dessert** - Although they look like clouds, these scoops of ice cream are flying high.

**Canned food container** - Flatbed wagons like this one are usually used to haul bales of hay, not giant cakes!

**Giant party food transport** - Ostriches cannot fly because their body is too big for their wings.

**A flightless African fowl** - A bovine is another name for a cow. This one has angel-like wings!

**An angelic young bovine** - Java is another name for coffee. This one is deep because it is a well!
